We are a small private farm. Should the weather be severely uncooperative and rainy the day prior to or the day of the show we will rain date the show. The morning of the show all participants please call our toll free number at 1 866-592-7362, a message will indicate if the show is to be postponed. We believe everyone who shows is a winner. Placings 1st through 6th and participant ribbons will be given in each class. Champion and reserve for each division will also be awarded. Points will be weighted based on the number of entries in each class. Champion and Reserve will be calculated based on the number of classes in the division participated in first, and then the total points accumulated. Ties for champion and reserve will be broken by the placing in the class marked with an asterisk. This year we will be offering 3 shows. Series points will be accumulated from each show and added toward Year End Placings. All points count toward the individual rider. To be eligible for a year end award you must participate in a minimum of 2 of the 3 total shows. The banquet will be held in March 2011.

1. All riders must wear headgear and boots. Juniors of all disciplines must wear a safety helmet.
2. Negative Coggins within one year required.
3. Schooling will be between divisions and before the show in the main ring No schooling anywhere else on the grounds
4. Classes may be combined or divided at the discretion of the show committee based on the number of entries the day of the show.
5. The Judge has the Final Say in all activities and Safety in the ring
6. Please do not enter the barns, or area by the house and pool
